The "Ruptured Duck", a lapel pin given to all servicemen who were honorably discharged during World War Two. Our Zuni brothers received these devices.

. A total of 272 hours were contributed toward the following maintenance and repairs:

1. Tested Potable Water System
2. Parts acquired and repairs were started on broken potable water lines
3. Removed concrete and cleaned part of Bridge Deck
4. Made welding repairs to pilot house (bridge) deck
5. Arranged equipment and supplies in the Electric and Ship fitters shops
6. Completed rewiring of helm in preparation of re-installation of 1943 equipment.
7. Reviewed No. 2 Fire Pump arrangement and operation.
8. Reviewed replacement of Starboard Electric Shore power connection.
9. Painted part of portside overhang.
10. Repainted and stenciled life rings.
11. Dressed ship for Flag Day.
12. Set up and broke down wiring connections for shipboard welding equipment
13. Preparations to acquire, transport and load a 3"50 deck gun for the ship.
14. Replaced chaffing gear on Aft mooring lines.
15. Re-ran temporary shore power lighting wiring.
16. Ran both No. 2 ships service generator and No. 3 Auxiliary generator
17. Removed scrap metal for recycling
18. Replaced worn oil line on No. 3 Auxiliary Generator
19. Prepared and served 16 meals
